- Apply online anytime
- Independent audit of 20% of wines
- Upload sourcing & blending docs
- Add the logo to your label design
- Submit Eligibility Letter to TTB[^]

COST AT A GLANCE

- Licensing Fees: see table below
(paid to Vineyard Team)
- Inspection Fees: 1–3 hours at \$100–\$175/hour
(paid to inspector)

ANNUAL CASES	\$/CASE	EXAMPLE
0–7,500	\$0.16	2,000 cases = \$320
7,500–24,999	\$0.12	12,000 cases = \$1,440
25,000–49,999	\$0.10	34,000 cases = \$3,400
50,000–99,999	\$0.08	75,000 cases = \$6,000
100,000–249,999	\$0.07	180,000 cases = \$12,600

FAQ

Q: My winery isn't SIP Certified. Can I still certify my wines?

Yes! Your winery doesn't need to be certified for you to certify your wines. Just be sure to use the appropriate logo/verbiage on your bottle (see Logo Use Guidelines below).

If your winery is certified, you may use the "SIP Certified Vineyard & Winery" version.

Q: How long does it take?

Most receive their Eligibility Letter in 14–30 days[^]. See timeline below.



Q: When should I apply?

First-time blends: at final blend stage
Repeat blends: post-bottle (if identical)

Q: Can purchasers of bulk wine certify?

Yes, as long as the final wine is $\geq 85\%$ SIP Certified fruit.

Q: What records do I need to provide?

Harvest and winemaking records.
Use the checklist (right) to gather your documents.
